






5. DISCUSSION ON WOMEN RESERVATION BILL



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9. CHILD MARRIAGE FREE INDIA – AWARENESS

Child Marriage is one of the worst forms of exploitation against childrens. It surpasses the barriers of caste, culture, and religion and has strong linkages with sexual abuse and trafficking. India reported the highest number of child marriages in the world among other countries where this evil tradition is still in practice. Estimates show around 23.3% of girls between the age group of 20-24 years have been married before they turned 18. It must be seen as a serious "crime against children" that violates their basic human rights.

Kailash Satyarthi Children's Foundation (KSCF), founded by the Nobel Peace Laureate Kailash Satyarthi launched a Pan-India campaign on creating Child Marriage Free India. This initiative is planned to run for about 3 years, covering at least 5,000 villages and engaging with more than 10 million citizens across the country to spread the message on fight against child marriage. The primary objective of the campaign is to reduce child marriages by 10% from the current level of 23.3% by end of the campaign in 2025. With this objective Department of Social Work and Women Development Cell Jointly organised Awareness and Pledge taking in association with Kailash Satyarthi Childrens Foundation, New Delhi at 16th October 2023 at Seminar Hall. This campeign created an awareness to fight against Child Marriege among the students of the college.




10. MOVIE SCREENING 'MARY KOM'


